

Call International IAMO-Alumni training for research managers 2023

“Sustainable rural development: Research environment and funding opportunities”

The Leibniz Institute of Agricultural Development in Transition Economies (IAMO) and Alumni IAMO e.V. invite applications by alumni (both IAMO and any other German higher education organisation) to an international training for research managers. The workshop takes place **04.-07.09.2023** in **Halle (Saale), Germany** and particularly invites research managers and researchers with interest in international collaborative funding acquisition. The program features presentations and discussions of the German and European research landscape related to rural development, the Ninth Research Framework of the European Union (Horizon Europe), and funding acquisition and management of international collaborative projects. Besides external speakers, participants are invited to share their experiences or report on recent developments in the research landscape of their countries. One excursion to research facilities and institutes in Central Germany will complement the programme. Furthermore, networking between alumni should be strengthened. Researchers from Europe and Asia's formerly centrally planned economies are particularly encouraged to apply.

Selection criteria

Eligible applicants must have stayed at least three months at any German university or research institute. Thus, former Bachelor, Master or PhD students and other researchers are invited to apply.

Application

Application will be open immediately. You can apply for the Summer School by sending an email with a CV and, in case applicable, a summary of your experience with European or other international collaborative research projects to **Ms Mara Kyritz (kyritz[at]iamo.de; subject: application IAMO-Alumni training 2023)** before **23 June 2023** (deadline extended). Admission decisions will be announced around 30 June 2023 (new date) and shared individually.

Registration fees and living costs

There is no registration fee for the training. Participants will receive a lump-sum reimbursement of 96 € per day plus travel costs but are responsible for their living costs (e.g., travel, housing and food expenses) during the workshop.
